New Orleans (7th & 9th Wards), LA

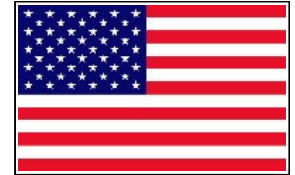
Johannesburg (Soweto), South Africa
